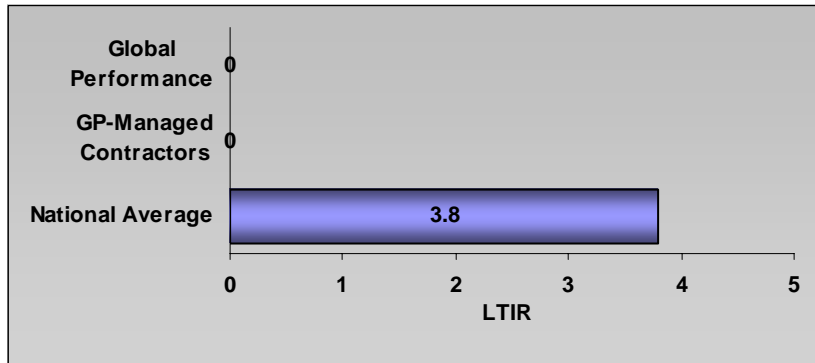

Project Overview

After the successful completion of construction and start-up of the first and second assembly lines for Honda in Lincoln, Alabama, Honda requested that the Global Performance team which was part of the first two phases remain and take responsibility for construction management, design coordination and start-up of their \$70 million Ferrous Machining Expansion.

Construction began March 1, 2005 and is progressing well with a target start of equipment installation date of April 1, 2006.
